Science Teacher Camps Set to Begin

This summer teachers will head back to school for ScienceSouth's seventh installment of Summer Science Teacher Camps, *The Amazing Race: to Infinity and Beyond!* The camps provide teachers with hands-on science, inquiry-based activities and content to take back to the classroom. Teachers also earn professional development credit upon completion of the three-day camps.

The first camp will be held in Bennettsville, SC from June 23-25, 2009 at Marlboro County High School for K-2nd grade teachers. The last camp will be held in Florence at Francis Marion University from July 7-9, 2009 for 3rd-5th grade teachers. Teachers may visit www.sciencesouth.org to reserve a slot.

Each of the three-day camps will culminate with a Science Challenge Day. On this day area children come and participate in a variety of activities that allow teachers to practice what they learned during the camp. Sidewalk Astronomer

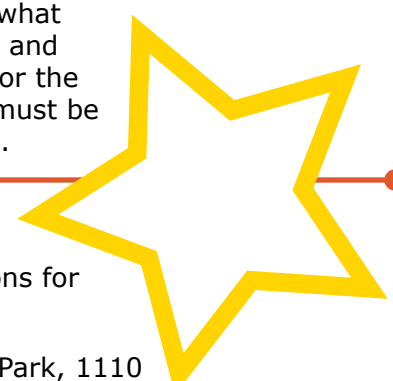
ScienceSouth's Sidewalk Astronomer programs are in full swing this summer. Here are the following dates and locations for viewings:
